The proposed activity is not a joinable tour, but a private tour that can be arranged upon request for

individuals or groups through a tourist agency. The tour can be customised based on the customer's preferences, including the start time, meeting place, and duration.

Duration of the Siena private tour

The tour can last up to 3 hours and includes a visit to the most captivating places in the historical centre, including Piazza del Campo, the medieval alleys, the area of one of the Contrade of Siena (a typical medieval neighbourhood whose organisation is linked to the historic Palio race), the medieval buildings, and the cathedral, where it is possible to access inside.

Cost of the Siena private tour

The cost for the private guided tour is, up to 3 hours, € 180.00 (total price and not per person).

Radio rental compulsory from 4 people onwards

For groups of 5 or more people, renting radio devices to facilitate listening to the guide's explanations and ensure social distancing outdoors and indoors is highly recommended. For visits inside the Cathedral or other Sienese museums, radios are mandatory for groups of 4 or more people. The guide will arrange the rental service, but the cost of € 2.00 per person for up to 3 hours, will be charged to the customer. The payment can be made directly to the guide, who will handle the payment to the supplier.

How to book the tour?

The tour can be booked by writing an email, calling +393332591526 or texting the guide (also via Whatsapp or Telegram) to check availability for the requested day. The payment for the tour can be made after the service, by credit card or cash.

Cancellation Policy

It is the responsibility of the guide to guarantee the guide service in any case. If, even for personal reasons, the guide is unable to perform the service on the date set with the client, it will be his concern to contact a reliable colleague who can replace him and therefore guarantee customer service.

The cancellation of the tour from the client can be done free of charge by giving timely notice to the guide 48 hours before the date and time agreed for the service. In this case, the customer **doesn't have** to pay anything. If instead cancellation is made by the customer when there are less than 48 hours before the date agreed for the service, the customer must pay an amount corresponding to 50% of the total rate.

The eventual tickets bought by the guide for the museums, whose money was advanced by the customer, are not refundable.

How to reach Siena?

By car

Reachable via the A1 motorway (<u>Siena-Bettolle</u> exit if coming from Rome; <u>Florence-Impruneta</u> exit if coming from Milan; then continue towards Siena with the Bettolle-Siena or Florence-Siena junction. The tour starts in the Fortezza area. In this area, there are free and paying car parks. The free car park spaces with white stripes are located along <u>Viale Vittorio Veneto</u>. Paying car parks, blue stripes, are located in <u>Via Fruschelli</u> (€ 1.50 hourly rate), or in the <u>Stadio</u> area (hourly rate € 2.00), the latter available in the days when no football matches are held.

Other car parks available close to the Duomo are "Il Campo", near Porta Tufi (hourly rate 2.00 €)

and "Il Duomo", near Porta San Marco (always 2.00 hourly rate).

By public bus lines

To get to Siena by public bus there are connections from Florence with rapid extra-urban lines (line 131). See the timetables by clicking here. Bus tickets can be purchased on the Autolinee toscane website, at retailers such as tobacco shops and newsstands or at the automatic columns near the bus stops.

By train

Siena can be reached by train with the <u>Trenitalia</u> service, thanks to the regional lines. Once you arrive at the Siena railway station, you can reach the historic centre:

On foot

By taking the <u>Camollia automatic electric escalator</u> and then from there enter the historic centre from <u>Porta Camollia</u>.

By Taxi service

- Particular requests(dog or cat, payment by card, driver's language, number of passengers if over 4, luggage if large).

Wait for the confirmation message with the code of the arriving taxi and the estimated time

Organised groups with a tourist coach

For **organised groups by touristic bus**, there are drop-off/drop-on points for passengers in the urban centre of Siena (**click here** to view the points).

Tourist coaches are subject to the payment of a **checkpoint** (more information **here**).

By Camper

Camper owners find rest areas around the historic centre. The closest one is in the area called **Fagiolone**. This is an equipped area with video surveillance (daily rate € 20.00; for more info **click here**. Other parking areas are in **Fontebecci** and the **Palasport Mensana** area. Another equipped area is the **Camping Siena Colleverde**.
